

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU) between SRI VENKATESWARA UNIVERSITY, TIRUPATI And CPF (INDIA) PRIVATE LIMITED, CHENNAI



- Parties: This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as "MOU,,) is made and entered into by and between the Sri Venkateswara University, Tirupati, Andhra Pradesh 517502, and the CPF (India) Private Limited, whose address is Head office: CPF (India) Private Limited, 10th Floor, Prasanth Real Gold Tower, 39, North Usman Road, Thyagaraya Nagar, Chennai-600 017.
- 2. Purpose: The purpose of this MOU is to establish the terms and conditions under which both the parties unitedly function to train scientifically and technically the post graduate M.Sc Aquaculture students from the Department of Fishery science & Aquaculture (fishery professionals) required for the industry.

In-plant Training: The Sri Venkateswara University, being a premier institute in the country is providing the requisite scientific and technical personnel through its state of the art professional degree and education system. The Sri Venkateswara University was established in 1954 by Andhra Pradesh State Government. UGC granted Autonomous and Category-I status in 2018 and NAAC accredited University with "A+" grade 2017. SCOPUS, an International Rating Organization in Academics, rated University as 19th best in India. In 2019 Times Higher Education Emerging Economies University Rankings SVU obtained 198th rank and in THE World rank 801-1000. University also squired QS University Rankings in India 38th rank; BRICS 153rd rank; in Asia 207th rank and QS I-Gauge Diamond Rating during 2019. The fish and shrimp industry in India is registering an upward growth with dearth for skilled and technical personnel. Whereas CPF (India) Private Limited, an international organization with demonstrated capabilities and skill in aquaculture has contributed richly to the growth of fish and shrimp industry in the country. Considering the customization of manpower to suite the industry both the parties have come down to sign an MOU wherein the Sri Venkateswara University will depute the final year Postgraduate students (M.Sc AQUACULTURE) from the Department of Fishery science & Aquaculture to rigorous "In-plant training" as part of the curriculum at designated hatchery/farm facility of CPF (India) Private Limited, where in the experts at CPF (India) Private Limited impart the required training to mold them to suit the industry.

Academic Partner: CPF (India) Private limited will partner with Sri Venkateswara University in designing the curriculum for the fishery students. CPF (India) Private Limited will involve senior members to support the university with the current Aqua trends and technique to build a business relevant curriculum for the students.

Campus Hire: CPF (India) Private limited is not legally bound to recruit students who completes Internship period during their curriculum. However, CPF (India) private limited follows its own recruitment policies & procedures in selecting the candidates, in which, the candidates who done internship will be given a opportunity to attend the interview.

3. <u>Term of MOU</u>: This MOU is effective upon the day and date last signed and executed by the duly authorized representatives of the parties to this MOU and the governing bodies of the parties' respectively and shall remain in full force and effect for not longer than 05 years. This MOU may be terminated, without cause, by either party upon written notice.

There shall not be any binding between both the parties with regard to the employment of the skilled personnel. However, the trainees are at their liberty to join CPF (India) Private Limited upon completion of their post graduate degree program, if they desire.

4. Responsibilities of Agencies: The responsibility of both the agencies lies in training skilled manpower. The Sri Venkateswara University shall shoulder the responsibility to make arrangements to send their postgraduate M.Sc Aquaculture students to the designated place of In-plant training. CPF (India) Private Limited on the other hand be responsible for costs and expenses related to the In-plant training, including the Stipend if any, benefits use of equipment belonging to the agencies while acting pursuant to this MOU.

5. General Provisions;

- A. **Period of internship:** The period and itinerary of the internship to be engaged in by the student is to be agreed upon by both parties which may be a short Term and Long Term, prior to the commencement of the internship.
- B. Code of conduct during the internship period: The student undertakes to abide by any employment rules set out by the host organization to facilitate the Program. The student agrees also to follow instruction and accept supervision throughout the internship period.

- C. Keeping confidentiality: The student agrees to keep strict confidentiality. On no grounds is he or she to disclose information obtained over the course of the program which is deemed classified by the host organization.
- D. Amendments: Either party may request changes to this MOU. Any changes, modifications, revisions, or amendments to this MOU which are mutually agreed upon by and between the parties to this MOU shall be incorporated by written instrument, and effective when executed and signed by all parties to this MOU.
- E. **Entirety of Agreement:** This MOU, consisting of 4 pages, represents the entire and integrated agreement between the parties and supersedes all prior negotiations, representations, and agreements, whether written or oral.
- F. **Severability:** Should any portion of this MOU be judicially determined to be illegal or unenforceable, the remainder of the MOU shall continue in full force and effect, and either party may renegotiate the terms affected by the severance.
- G. Sovereign Immunity: Both the agencies and their respective governing bodies do not waive their sovereign immunity by entering into this MOU, and each fully retains all immunities and defenses provided by law with respect to any action based on or occurring as a result of this MOU.
- H. **Evaluation:**Both Short-term and long-term interns must submit an internship report to the host organization's internship supervisor at the end of his/her internship period. The internship supervisor should submit an evaluative report to both HR department and up on request, to the Institute/College/University based on their observations of the student's performance over the period of his/her internship.

The rights, duties and obligations contained in this MOU shall operate only between the parties to this MOU, and shall insure solely to the benefit of the parties to this MOU. The provisions of this MOU are intended only to assist the parties in determining and performing their obligations under this MOU.

PREAMBLE:

The Centre For Southeast Asian & Pacific Studies (CSEAPS). Tirupati and the Allahabad State University, Allahabad having realised the need for a close linkage between the National Think Tanks and the Universities in terms of research and academic activities have decided to come together to enhance co-operative faculty research, training national/International and to conduct post graduate research students conferences/workshops and run short/long term post graduate courses in the special areas of Area studies programme (ASP). In compliance to this idea, the CSEAPS. Tirupati and the Allahabad State University, Allahabad have decided to sign a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) as per following terms and conditions.

1 GENERAL:

- ASU. Allahabad will recognise CSEAPS as an accredited centre for pursuing research leading to Ph.D degree in subjects related to Area studies programme. For this purpose, students having a Master Degree in the relevant subject from institutions recognised by ASU, Allahabad, and having qualified the rigorous pre-PhD course work of ASU. Allahabad and those sponsored by CSEAPS would be allowed to register for Ph.D. in the faculty of Science, ASU, Allahabad.
- 1.2 CSEAPS faculty, research staff and post graduate research students will participate in the research, training and teaching programme of ASU. Allahabad especially to cover the new emerging area of Area studies programme (ASP) in the ASU. Allahabad upon request and subject to mutual convenience and vice-versa.
- 1.3 CSEAPS, Tirupati, research, faculty members and post graduate research students of ASU. Allahabad will work towards joint research projects thereby mutually using research facilities developed / to be developed at CSEAPS and ASU, Allahabad.
- 1.4 The faculty and students of the ASU, Allahabad shall be allowed to use library computer and internet facilities of CSEAPS, Tirupati, subject to the terms and conditions of CSEAPS, Faculty Staff and Ph.D. students of CSEAPS, Tirupati, shall like wise be given the above mentioned facilities at ASU, Allahabad.



BACKGROUND

B. SVIMS and SVU seek to record their collaboration (as described in Clause A) in this MoU.

1. GUIDING PRINCIPLES AND PURPOSE OF THE MEMORANDUM

- The following guiding principles are intended to govern the relationship between the Parties. Each Party shall:
 - > Always act in good faith towards the other Party;
 - > Be accessible and communicate openly and honestly with the other Party;
 - > Work in a constructive and cooperative manner; and
 - > Encourage new approaches to achieve positive outcomes where possible.
- Applying the principles in clause 1 the Parties intend to promote academic and research collaboration which are mutually beneficial.
 - > To meet these goals, the Parties intend to support their mutual interests.

2. IMPLEMENTING THE GOALS OF THE MoU

- > The department of sports physiotherapy, SVIMS will undertake teaching sessions theory & practical's related to physiotherapy and rehabilitation for various sports injuries through online/offline to the students pursuing Bachelor of Physical Education (B.P.Ed) in the department of Physical education of SV University, Tirupati.
- > Physiotherapy treatment services to the injured students of B.P.Ed.
- On field management by posting sports physiotherapists for the various sports meets conducted by the Department of Physical education, SVU.
- Assessment of components of fitness for the athletes and players from the department of physical education, SVU which aid in preventing sports injuries.
- As a part of academic curriculum, the elective sports students pursuing MPT should do dissertations requiring subjects who are either athletes or players of various disciplines who will be available in the department of Physical education, SVU.
- > During university external practical examinations, sports injured subjects can be recruited from the department of Physical education, SVU.
- > Free services for organising sports meet in SVIMS from the department of physical education SVU.

3. REPRESENTATIVE

- During the Term, each Party shall nominate a Representative who will be responsible for managing the relationship and coordinating the exchange of relevant information between the Parties.
- > The Representatives must consult with each other as required to review the operation of the MoU.
- > A Party may change its Representative by providing written notice to the other Party.

4. CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

- > The Parties may exchange Confidential Information (including to employees of a Party) during the term of the MoU.
- The Receiving Party must not disclose the Disclosing Party's Confidential Information without first obtaining the consent of the Disclosing Party in writing.
- > The Receiving Party agrees to take reasonable steps to provide for the safe custody of the Disclosing Party's Confidential Information in its possession and to prevent unauthorised access to or use of the Disclosing Party's Confidential Information.
- > The obligations in this clause 4 survive the termination or expiration of this MoU.

5. REVIEW, TERM AND TERMINATION

- The MoU commences on the Effective Date and continues for the Term, unless terminated earlier or extended as provided for in clause 5.
- The Parties will review the benefits of the collaboration and the operation of this MoU one year before the MoU ends to decide whether the MoU will be renewed for a further term. The MoU will only be renewed by mutual written agreement of the Parties.
- This MoU may be terminated by either Party providing six (6) months written notice to the other Party.
- Any separate agreement entered into by the Parties (as set out in clause 2) may survive termination or expiration of this MoU

GENERAL PROVISIONS The following general provisions apply:

- > Acknowledgment: The Parties acknowledge that this MoU does not restrict the right of each Party to act in its discretion in relation to its business activities or any existing or new commitments.
- Legal Effect: With the exception of clause 4, this MoU is not intended to create legal relations and is not legally binding on the parties.

- > Agency: Nothing in this MoU gives rise to a relationship of agency between the

- > Assignment: Neither Party may assign this MoU or any right under this MoU without

- > Force Majeure: Neither Party will be liable to the other for the consequences of any delays or failures of its performance which are caused by any event beyond the first party's reasonable control, including without limitation acts of God, fire, flood, accident, terrorism, strike and riots and either Party may terminate the MoU by written notice if such an event occurs and continues for a period of 30 days or more.
 - > Other Laws: In carrying out obligations set out under this MoU, each Party shall comply with all relevant laws, policies, and requirements of the other Party as notified by the other Party from time to time.

DEFINITIONS In this MoU: The singular includes the plural and vice versa.

"Confidential Information" means all information:

- disclosed by the Disclosing Party to the Receiving Party or of which the Receiving
- which is by its nature confidential or is identified as confidential by the Disclosing Party, but does not include information which:
- is required to be disclosed by law;
- is in the public domain other than by breach of this MoU; or the Receiving Party has developed or obtained independently of the Disclosing Party.
 - "Disclosing Party" means the Party that is disclosing Confidential Information.
 - "Effective Date" means the date the last Party signs this MoU.
 - "MoU" means this memorandum of understanding.
 - "Party" means a Party to this MoU and "Parties" has a corresponding meaning.
 - "Receiving Party" means the Party that is receiving Confidential Information.
 - "Representative" means an employee of either Party appointed to act as its representative in relation to this MoU and who will be responsible for identifying any matters that arise between the Parties and the referral of those matters to the appropriate person within the Representative's organisation in accordance with clause 3.
 - "Term" means five (5) years from the Effective Date.
