REPORT ON INTERNATIONAL LITERACY DAY CELEBRATIONS AT Z. P. HIGH SCHOOL CHERLOPALLI

(8th September, 2020)

Literacy is a qualitative attribute of the population is one of the most important indicators of the socio economic development of the country. It is a major component of the human resource development and is thus basic to any programme of socio economic development. Recognising the importance literacy, the Government has been implementing to achieve total the problem of literacy was discussed for the first time at the international level in the World Congress of Ministers of Education at Tehran in 1965 UNESCO declared September, 8th as International Literacy Day. 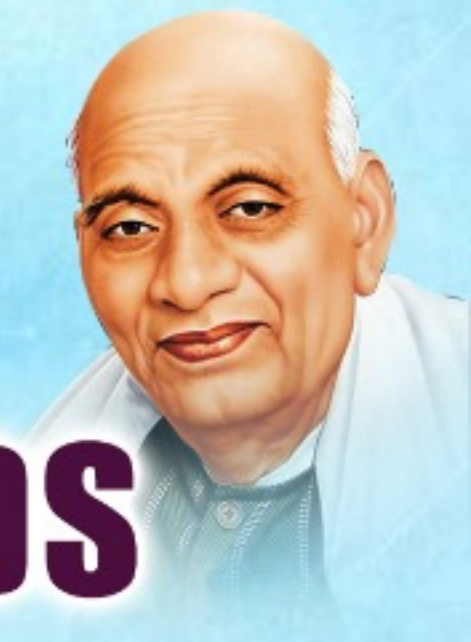
