2.5.1 Reforms in Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE) system at the institutional level:

The S.V. University follows the Examination pattern strictly adhered to with respect to evaluation process. There are Two Internal tests conducted. The schedules of internal assessments are communicated to students and faculty in the beginning of the semester through institute academic calendar which is prepared based on the University academic calendar.

The institute has reformed the continuous internal evaluation system from faculty centric to student centric. The Institute Exam cell framed guidelines for conducting the CIE in line with calendar of the University. As per the guidelines, the following reforms have been carried out effectively conducting CIE:

- Scheduling of Internal Examination, Seating arrangements, hall invigilators listed for every examination.
- Preparing the question paper for the internal examination in the prescribed pattern based on Knowledge level using revised Bloom's taxonomy.
- Scrutiny of the prepared question paper is carried out by HoD/ Subject expert to ensure quality of the Question paper.
- Monitoring the attendance of the students for the Examination.
- Internal Assessment has to be carried out within the stipulated time.
- After completion of the internal examination, the faculty evaluate the answer scripts and distribute to the students for doubt clarifications or re-correction. The faculty submits the re-corrected scripts to the examination branch and marks are displayed on the notice board.
- Result review meetings are conducted with result analysis and the remedial actions for further improvements are arrived after discussion with faculty, HoD and Principal.
- Upload of assessment marks in university web portal and subsequently communicated to parents.

The evaluation for theory courses are assessed in direct mode (80%) covering University examinations and (20%) through internal tests covers survey.

The evaluation for laboratory courses are assessed in the similar pattern followed for theory courses. For each laboratory sessions, the student is assessed through viva questions, observations.

The evaluation for project course is assessed by conducting periodical project reviews covering key parameters like problem formulations, understanding of the project, presentation skills, communication of ideas, technical knowledge, team work and project management. Major project consists of 200 marks. The project review committee organizes review meetings to assess the progress of all the project batches.

Performance of the students in Internal Assessment is used for Faculties to identify slow and advanced learners in their respective subjects. Slow Learners are encouraged to improve their performance in future by counseling. Counseling Sessions are used to sort out the personal issues, academic and non-academic problems.

Policy for Internal Assessment

The S.V University provides quality education to students. The institution believes that assessment is integral and vital touchstone of the teaching-learning process and linked to the learning objectives. The assessment should foster and be instrumental to judge the inherent as well as the acquired skills of every learner. Besides, it should stimulate creative and critical thinking amongst learners and inspire independent thinking and concurrently encourage the students to accomplish the measurable goals in their fascinating journey of education. Further, the institution considers that the main objective of internal assessment is to facilitate planning and enhance the processes of student learning, and not just focus on grades. Internal assessment is a strategy implemented to gauge the knowledge, understanding, and skills attained by learners.

Aims of the policy

The aims of the internal assessment policy are to ensure that:

- The internal assessment is robust and transparent to nurture the inherent as well as the acquired skills of the learners.
- The internal assessment process in the institution comprises a variety of modes viz. formal and informal assessment methods to assess individual potential of the learners
- The frequency of formal and informal internal assessment methods is adequate to facilitate the assessment better judgements about students' attainment.
- The internal assessment process supports objectives of prescribed syllabus and to encourage appropriate student learning.
- The internal assessment is impersonal, fair and executed effectively to gauge the knowledge, understanding, and skills of the students.
- The internal assessment is robust and efficient to evaluate the participation of students in various co-curricular and extra-curricular activities.

Planning and Organization

The University is aware of the need for catering learners from diverse background and requirements of individual learners. Therefore, formal and informal assessment methods in this regard must be executed. The formal assessment methods must comprise unit tests, home assignments, in-house examination and other suitable methods to encourage the creative and higher order thinking. The internal

assessment must include informal assessment methods like attendance of a student, response to tutorials, learner's involvement while doing practical, interest in field projects, participation while doing research projects, participation in seminars and oral presentations, active participation in classroom teaching, and timely submission of assignments.

There shall be a committee, which shall look after the examination related aspects and responsible for circulation of rules, notifications, circulars and other documents related to internal assessment received from affiliating university. The head of the departments and faculty members shall assure that schedule of class tests, home assignments is made known to the students well in advance through notices and the Academic Calendar. The internal assessment shall be conducted in the manner of university examinations with invigilation by teachers of all departments.

Responsibilities of Teachers

1. The teachers shall follow the rules and regulations verbalized by the affiliating university and college administration during the conduct of internal assessment.
2. It is the responsibility of the head of the department and faculty members to inform students about when an assessment is going to take place. It is important that clear, accurate information is provided within an appropriate timescale in order to be able to organise it without any issue. That is, the teachers will appraise all students about the rules and regulations of the examination.
3. The students need to know precise dates and unit/chapter on which a faculty member is planning to conduct internal assessment. Any change must be brought to the notice of students immediately.
4. All faculty members involved in the process of internal assessment must be provided details of the internal assessment like schedule, etc.
5. Individual subject teachers are responsible for implementation of the assessment policy, smooth conduction of internal assessment and periodic assessment of students. The subject teachers must maintain regularity, periodicity and use of ICT tools for internal assessment to assure the fulfilment of this policy.

Taking of Internal Assessments

1. The in-house examination must be conducted as per the pattern of university examinations to provide first-hand experience to the students of the entry year. The head of the department shall appoint an invigilator other than the regular teacher during conduct of the unit test to assure transparency during assessment.
2. The students should be given enough time and opportunities to interact with the teacher to resolve their grievances, if any, regarding the assessment.

3. Students' grievances related to internal assessment must be redressed in a timely manner with transparency.
4. The performance levels of the slow and advanced learners should be particularly evaluated to know the effect of special assistance provided to them.
5. If a student is absent, the teacher must allow that student the chance to make up the time if necessary.
6. If suspected malpractice occurs, appropriate actions against those who commit malpractices must be executed.

Post Internal Assessment Process:

Merely conduction of internal assessments is not sufficient to achieve the purpose unless effective measures are executed to augment the performance of the students. After the evaluation, the answer books are to be shown to the students to enhance self-evaluation and for their self-satisfaction.

The model answers must be discussed in the classroom to enable the learners to understand their mistakes and to bring required changes into their approach while answering the questions. In addition, all unit tests marks within stipulated time after unit tests must be displayed and brought to notice of students.

The learners, who underperform in the internal assessment or are absent, must be provided adequate counselling and support through mentoring system and the concerned HOD. If required, parents must be informed telephonically or during the visits to the houses of the mentees.

Examination Evaluation Mechanism of the Institution

The institute conducts several and continuous evaluations. Different information dissemination techniques, such as the college calendar, have implicitly reflected this. Each student and member of the faculty receives a copy of the Calendar at the beginning of the year. The examination coordinator is in charge of the Internal Tests and the University examination logistics. Students are constantly evaluated using the following methods:

Methods	Evaluation Details
Assessment through Internal Tests	Internal tests are used to evaluate students in accordance with the University's regulations and norms. The Head/co-ordinator will work with the Principal to plan the internal assessment test schedule for the coming academic year. Dates of internal tests, evaluations and information to check for malpractice are included in the schedule. The timetable is shared amongst the instructors and posted on the notice board and whatsapp group for students to see, as well as announced in the classrooms themselves.
Assessment through University Examination	Rules, regulations, and recommendations given from time to time by the affiliating university dictate how University examinations are performed. For the benefit of enrolled students, university announcements are posted on the notice board. In the orientation session, students learn about the exam schedule, restrictions, and evaluation process.
Assessment Through Assignments	Faculty in charge of each subject will plan and announce the topics and dates for students to write assignments at the end of each chapter, which will be graded. The basis for evaluation is the quality and timeliness of the assignments that are turned in by students.
Assessment through Attendance	Even though the University requires at least a 75 percent attendance rate in order to sit for exams, the college encourages students to show up as much as possible by awarding internal marks as incentives.
Evaluation through Class Room Discipline	Students are encouraged to compete for the best outgoing student award in order to maintain discipline in the classroom. At the college annual day celebration, these awards are given out.
Evaluation Through Participation in Co-Curricular activities	As part of the evaluation process, the College encourages students to participate in all co-curricular activities within and outside of the College. It is possible for students to score CBCS pattern grades.
Evaluation through Subject Based Viva-Voce	Subject-based viva-voce examinations are used to evaluate students in all of the college's programmes. The performance in the viva-voce is assigned a certain number of internal marks.

Mechanism to deal with internal/external examination related grievances is transparent, time-bound and efficient:

Grievances handling mechanism is completely transparent. Starting of every semester all faculty members described the evaluation process of internal marks and external marks. Internal examination test schedules are prepared and communicated to student in advance. For proper conduction of test two invigilators are assigned in room and evaluation of answer sheet is done by concern subject faculty member with in three working days. Internal examination grievances are cleared by showing the corrected answer sheet to student. He/she many times have grievance after comparison with fellow student's answer sheet. This is satisfied by Evaluator/concerned faculty member by explaining the reason for difference of marks. Rules of entry and exit in exam hall are obeyed strictly so no point of grievance in this domain. Final sessional marks are uploaded to university portal and daily attendance also uploaded on university portal by concern subject faculty members. Detained list is prepared well in advance with a common criteria, if any grievance is observed in it, is resolved for medical reasons/emergency. For lab course Continuous assessment of every experiment is prepared by concern faculty member followed by viva voice and lab record.

For complete transparency and mall practice in semester Theory examination conducted by other center and for practical examination, university assigned an examiner from other college. University examination result may be challenged by scrutiny/re-evaluation. Form for scrutiny/re-evaluation is shared by the university after about a month from the result Declaration. Students having doubts in marks, fill this form with a nominal Exam fees. Scrutiny process is for checking of total marks and for any unchecked portion in the answer sheet whereas re-evaluation process (also known as challenge evaluation) is carried out by re- evaluation of answer sheet by another faculty member. This whole process is conducted in such a way so as the student gets updated result within the same semester; hence it is a time-bound process. Further, it is also efficient as its being done with honesty.

1. Mechanism of internal assessment is transparent and robust in terms of frequency and variety

Complete transparency is maintained in all forms of internal evaluations. Two internal examinations, namely Class Test I and Class Test in each semester are planned in academic calendar and executed. After assessment, answer sheets are distributed and discussed with students to maintain transparency. Examination results are displayed on notice boards and on University website. Overall performance, attendance, feedback about the student is communicated to parents during parents meet.

Term work (TW) assessment

Various assessment parameters, their evaluation process and criteria are discussed by each course teacher with students on day one of academics. The same are displayed on the notice board of the department.

Continuous assessment I and II are conducted as per the guidelines of S.V University, Following methodologies are used for evaluating the performance of the students

- Online Test
- Surprise Test
- Presentations
- Survey/Case Studies
- Mini Projects

The CA I and CA II are conducted by every course teacher twice in a semester. The performance is communicated to the students and signatures are also taken.

For practical subjects, a separate practical evaluation sheet is maintained by each course teacher which is used to record performance of the students for each practical. After the completion of each practical faculty assesses the performance of the students using pre-defined parameters and student signature is taken on evaluation marks.

For S.V University there is only head for term work assessment. This term work assessment is carried out using a separate practical evaluation sheet which is used to record performance of the students for each practical. After the completion of each practical faculty assesses the performance of the students using pre-defined parameters and student signature is taken on evaluation marks.

Performance of each student for practical sessions is recorded daily in practical evaluation sheet and term work of a student, which carries weightage in final university result, is evaluated based on performance in practical evaluation sheet.

Project and Seminar

As part of the internal assessment of projects and seminar, a review committee is formed which comprises of all the project guides and Head of the department. The project coordinator is appointed to look after the smooth conduction of project related activities. Students are allotted projects into groups. The project guide monitors the performance of the students regularly. The review committee of the department takes the review seminars/presentation and the suggestion/ correction/ modification, are given to the students. Two/three reviews are taken on project by a committee constituted in the department. The performances of the students in review are recorded against pre-defined parameters and the same are used to calculate the marks of the students interm work.




