
WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY






NATIONAL GIRL CHILD DAY

NATIONAL STATISTICS DAY


Every year National Statistics Day is celebrated on 29th June in the University. Guest lectures, workshops are organized on this day.




RHAPSODY (ANNUAL CULTURAL EVENT)








Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA)
