- Action taken to invite more companies for placement of students online and offline.





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

- Separate committee was formed to resolve student grievances.


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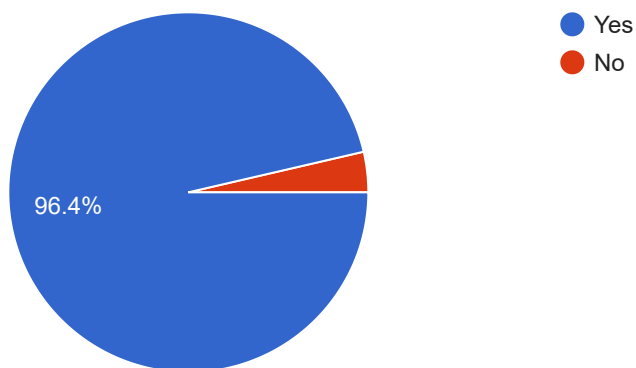

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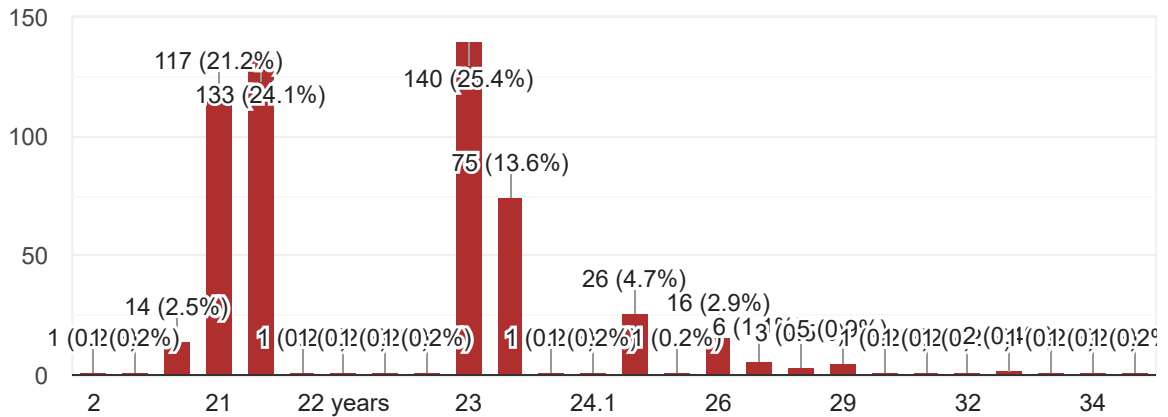

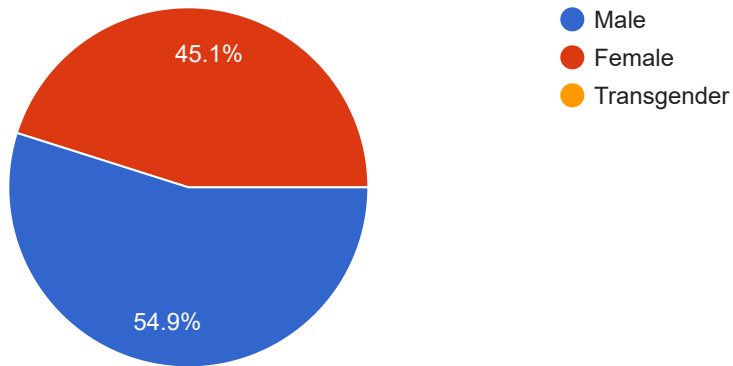

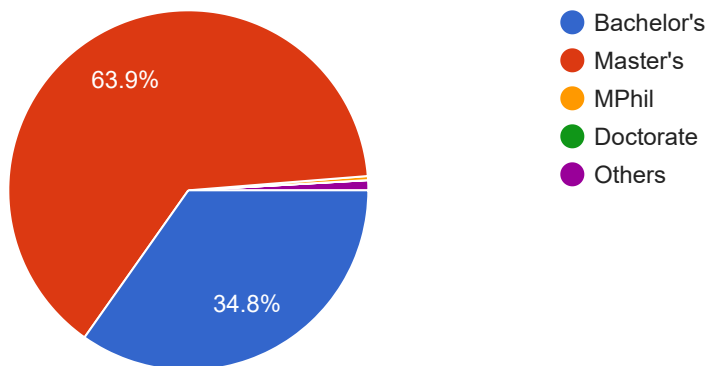

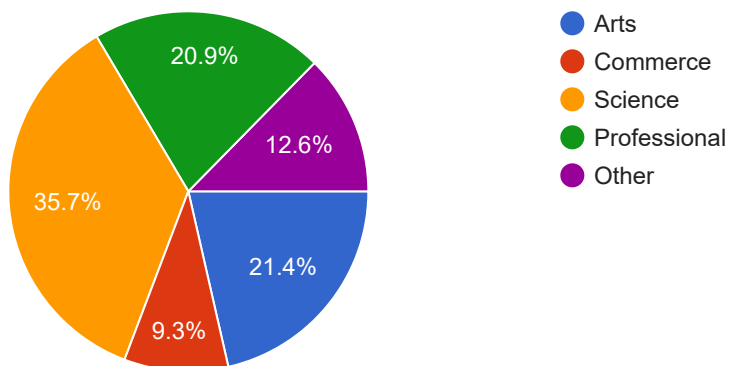

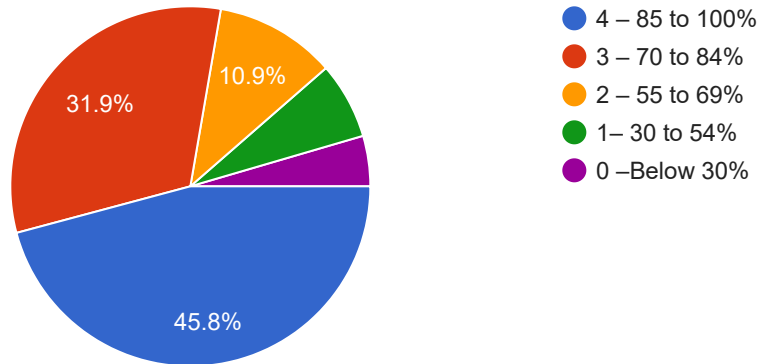

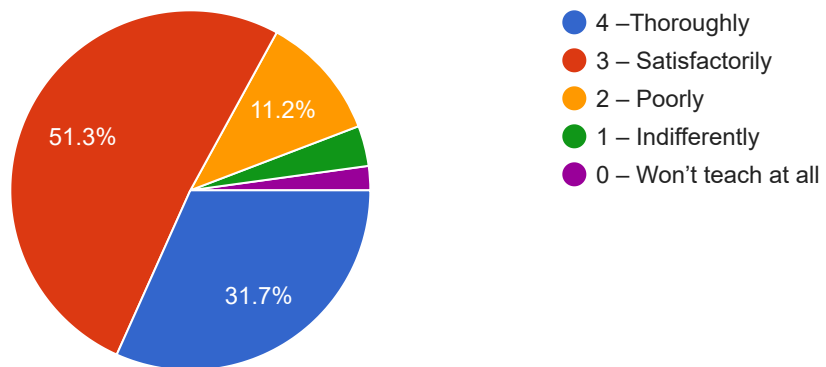

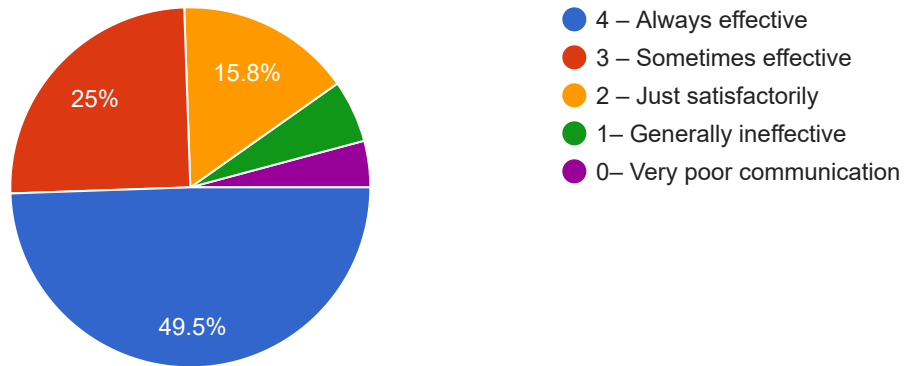
2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?

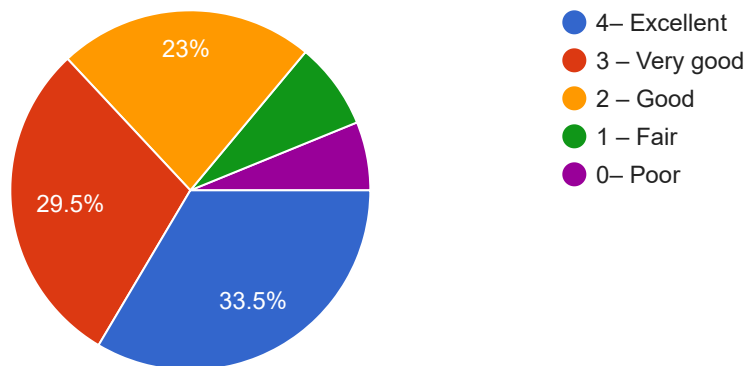
3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?

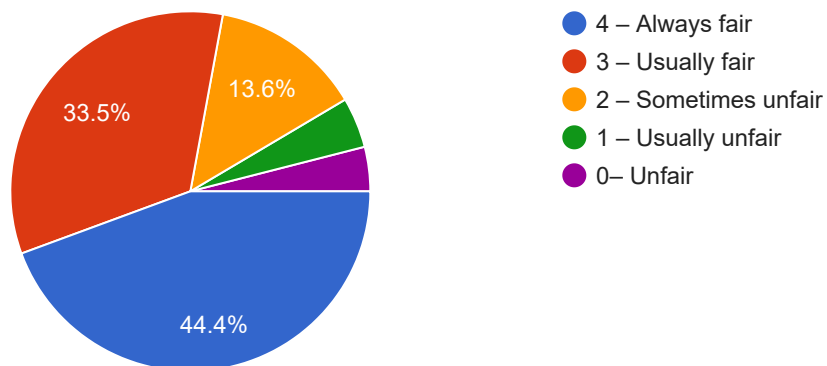
4. The teacher’s approach to teaching can best be described as

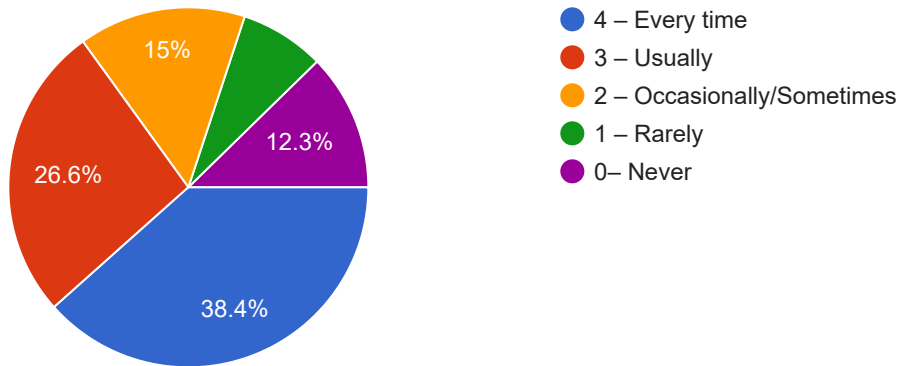

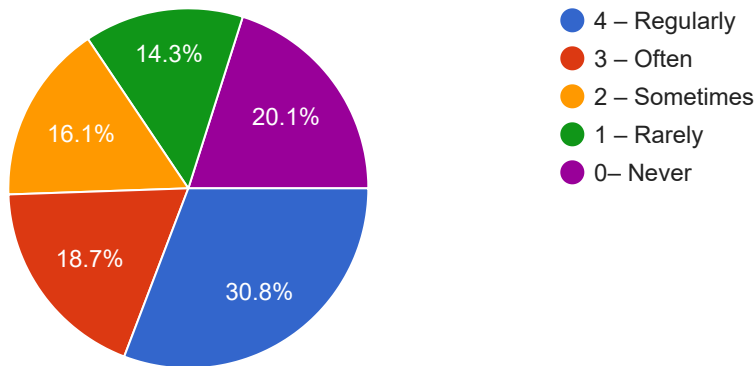

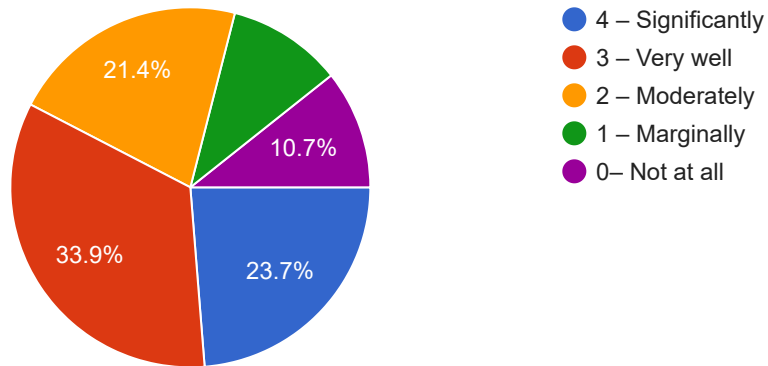

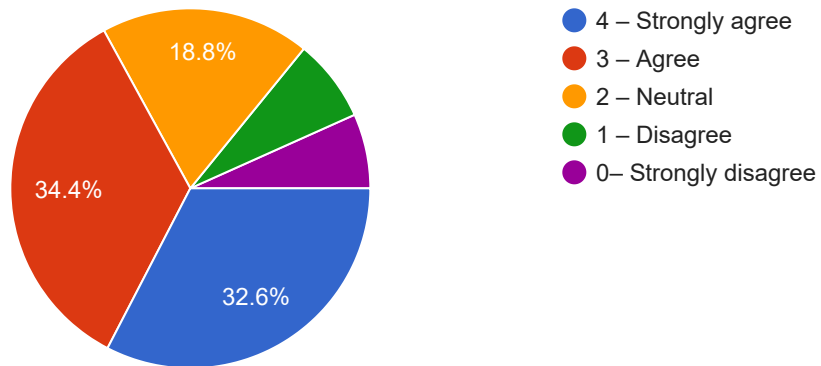

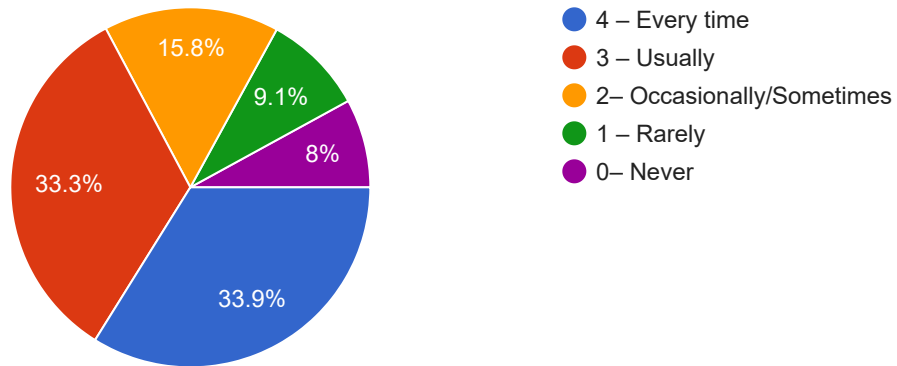

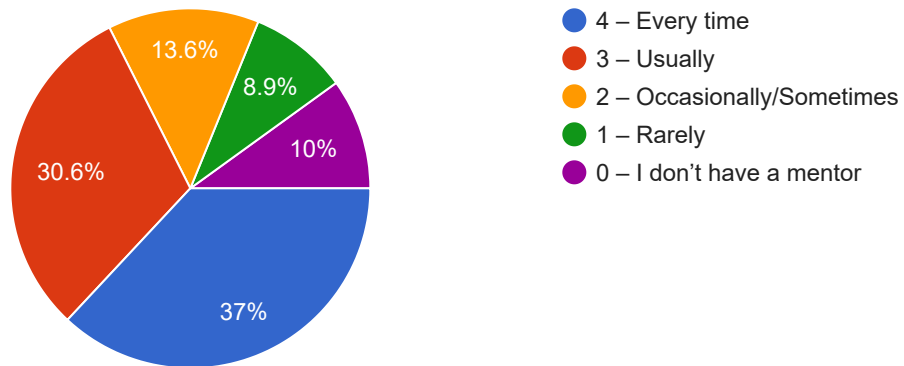

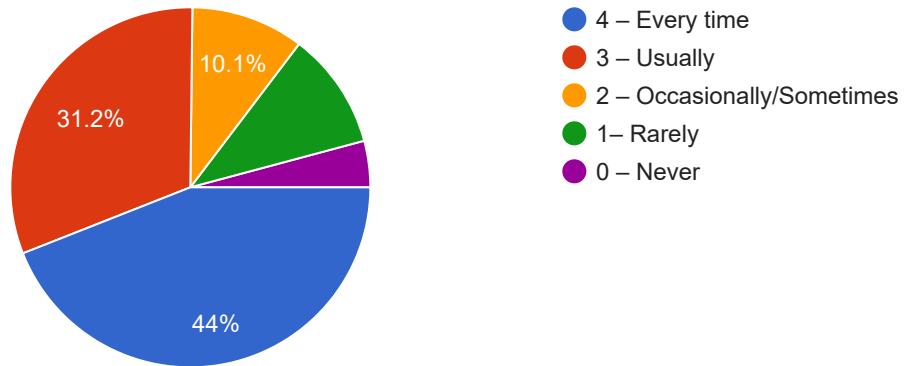

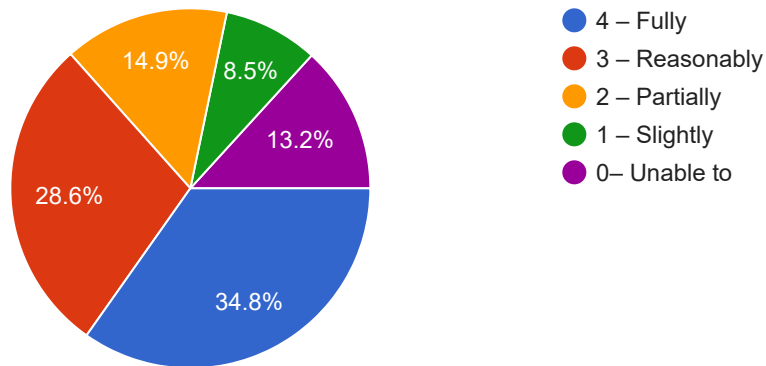

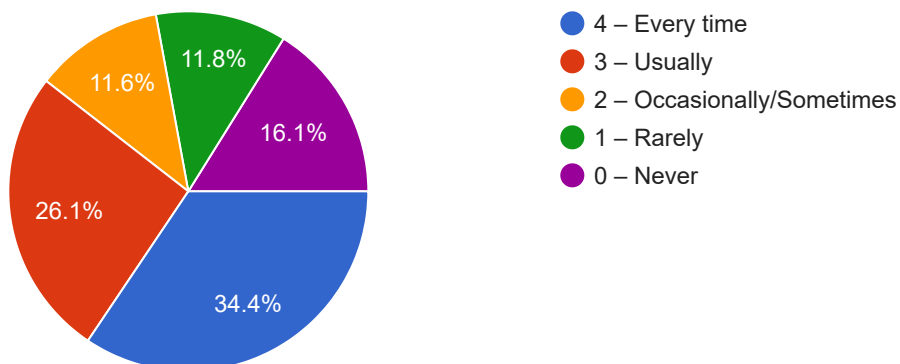

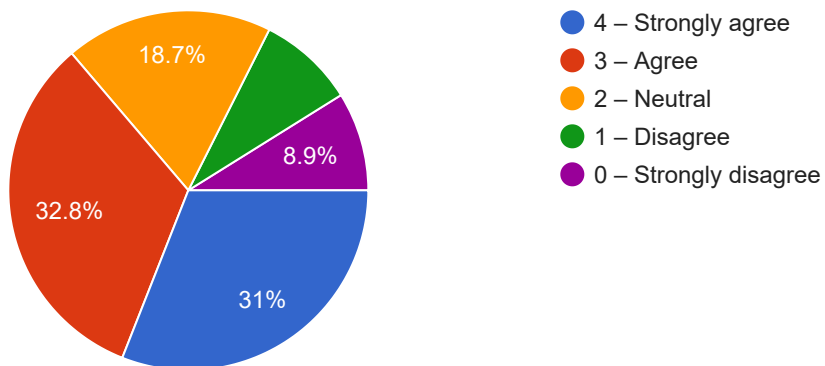

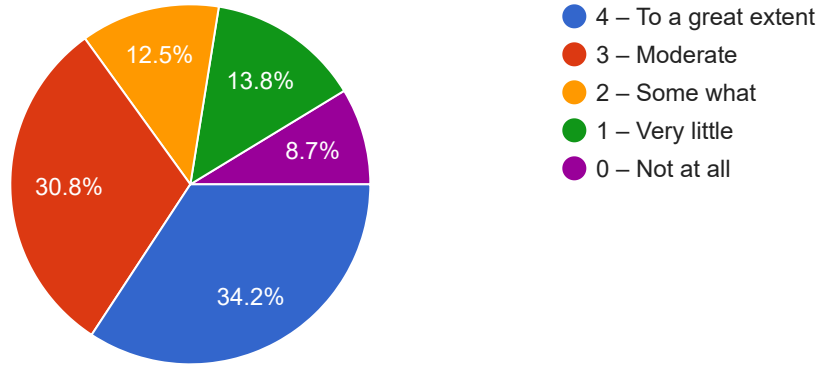

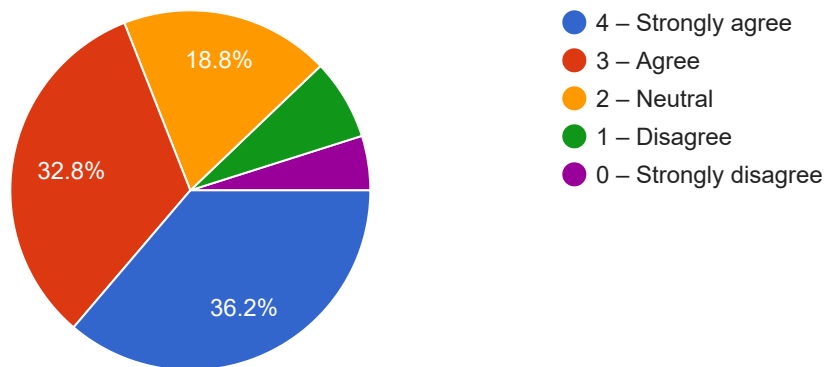

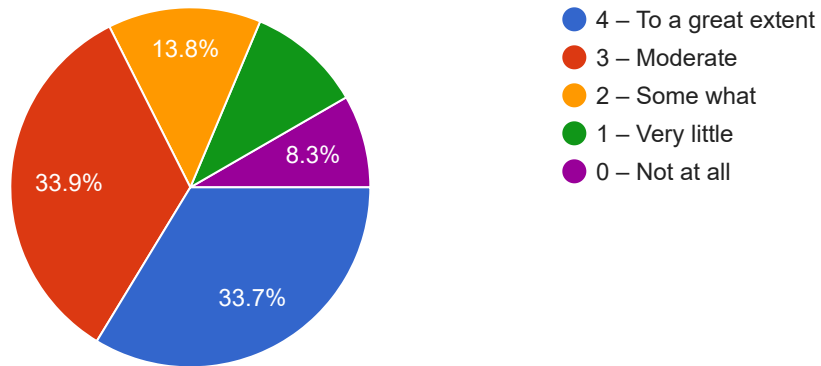

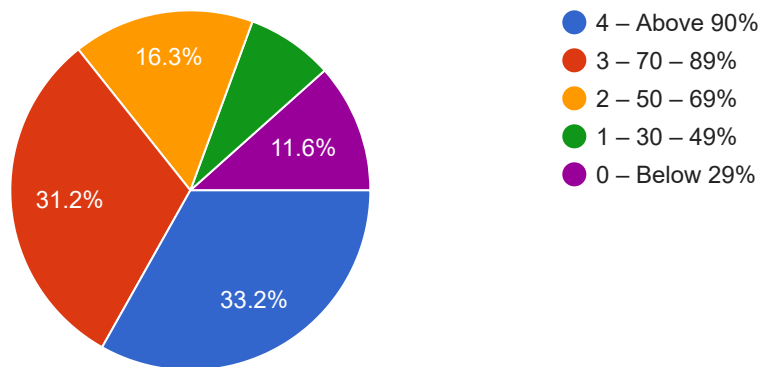

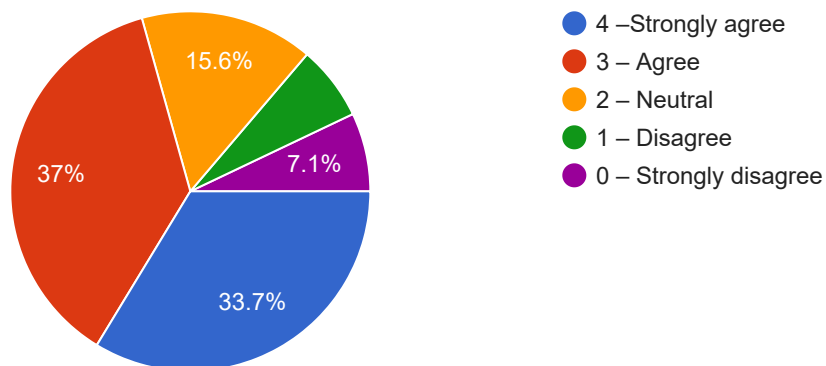
19. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching.

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STUDENT SATISFACTORY SURVEY 2020-21

Some expressed the view that faculty have good rapport with the students and modern techniques and tools are used in the process of teaching, some are of the opinion that the funds are properly used by the University colleges which periodically purchase the required equipment and chemicals. According to many students, the University has good teaching faculty with good subject knowledge and communications skills. Students expressed the need for more practical sessions.

A few more students opined that university provides all facilities to students such as accommodation, environment sports, games, library and the university has excellent professors.

Some students opine that the university is very effective and helps to overcome their weakness besides improving their skills. They believe that the teachings are beneficial to them to face their careers. A few students expressed the view that the syllabus and curriculum planning is awesome. Teachers support the students well and guide them properly to reach their goals. Some are of the opinion that the university provides lots of opportunities for students to grow well in their career. The university provides update technology and industrial visits is the opinion of some students.

A few students expressed that during pandemic teachers have put all efforts to teach them well to get a better understanding of the subjects. The dedication and efforts of the teachers make the students attain their masters degrees worthy is the comment of a few other students. The use of technology in pandemic is appreciated by one and all. The faculty is very responsible is what some students opined.

They further expressed that the number of student teachers interactions should be increased. Some expressed that the faculty are giving more than their best to place the students at top in their careers. A few expressed that the university has the best library.

Students expressed their concern for the university in the survey. A great majority of the students are of the view that interactive sessions, quiz, seminars, assignment works are to be increased further, periodical assignments may be given importance in the semester grading process. They suggested more elective courses may be introduced in the curriculum. They felt there is energetic environments over the campus with innovative programmes.

Besides appreciation many students suggested a few drawbacks of the university specially in the conduct and release of semesters exams results infrastructure facilities and faculty. They also suggested more campus drives are to be initiated. They further suggested the need for more assignments, internship, programmes, practical hours, industrial visits for better prospects in their future careers.


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
