Considered revising the Scheme of Instruction and Syllabi of 4-Year B.Tech Programme in 2-Year M.Tech Programme in CSE vide Registra s CII(B)B.Tech/M.Tech(CSE)-Syllabi-2018/AS/2019 dated 09-092019 and assed the resolutions given hereunder:

- 1. It is resolved to recommend for ratifying the Scheme of Instuction and Examinations, and detailed syllabi for I, II and III semesters 4-Year B.Tech Programme in Computer Science and Engineering that was placed before the Academic Senate meeting held on 16-05-2019 (shown in Anne: ure-I) since it is already in force from the academic year 2018-19 as a part of 2018 Regulations.
- 2. It is resolved to recommend for approving the revised Scheme of Ins uction and Examinations for IV, V, VI, VII and VIII semesters of 4-Year B.Tech Programme in Computer Science and Engineering (shown in Annexure-II). This is to come into force from the academic year 2019-20 as a part of 2018 Regulations.
- 3. It is resolved to recommend for approving the detailed syllabi inclusive of course objectives, course outcomes, textbooks, and reference books for each couse of fourth (IV) semester of 4-Year B.Tech Programme in Computer Science and Engineering (shown in Annexure-III).
