


Considered revising the Scheme of Instruction and Syllabi of 4-Year B.Tech Programme in CSE and 2-Year M.Tech Programme in CSE vide Registrar's Lr.No. CII(B)B.Tech/M.Tech(CSE)-Syllabi-2018/AS/2019 dated 09-09-2019 and passed the resolutions given hereunder:

1. It is resolved to recommend for ratifying the Scheme of Instruction and Examinations, and detailed syllabi for I, II and III semesters of 4-Year B.Tech Programme in Computer Science and Engineering that was placed before the Academic Senate meeting held on 16-05-2019 (shown in Annexure-I) since it is already in force from the academic year 2018-19 as a part of 2018 Regulations.
2. It is resolved to recommend for approving the revised Scheme of Instruction and Examinations for IV, V, VI, VII and VIII semesters of 4-Year B.Tech Programme in Computer Science and Engineering (shown in Annexure-II). This is to come into force from the academic year 2019-20 as a part of 2018 Regulations.
3. It is resolved to recommend for approving the detailed syllabi inclusive of course objectives, course outcomes, textbooks, and reference books for each course of fourth (IV) semester of 4-Year B.Tech Programme in Computer Science and Engineering (shown in Annexure-III). This is to come into force from the academic year 2019-20 as a part of 2018 Regulations.


