ABOUT THE DEPARTMENT

The Department of Sociology was started in 1971, as combined Department of Anthropology and Sociology with two teaching faculty, Prof. A.S.N. Murthy and Prof. M.S. N. Reddy and became in independent Department in 1975.

The Department offers three courses: M.A., Ph.D. Programmes to be abreast with social demands and keeping in view the social relevance the department makes selective choices of areas for teaching, research and extension. The Departmental Library has a good collection of over 600 books and an audio system.

The course curriculum is job / career-oriented offering electives in emerging and inter-disciplinary areas like Sociology of Development and Welfare, Medical Sociology and Environmental sociology Criminology. The Department has a 'Career Guidance Cell' catering to the career prospects of the student fraternity.

The students of III semester carryout field work by staying in the field by at least ten days for collection of primary data on a specific theme individually and also apply PRA techniques. They submit a Field Report at the end of the semester. Further, they prepare and submit a dissertation after the analysis of data.
