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






### **DEPARTMENT OF HOME SCIENCE**




#### **DEPARTMENT OF ADULT EDUCATION**

The Department of Adult Education has organised **International Literacy Day Celebrations and International Literacy Week celebrations** on 8 September, 2021 under the theme "Literacy for a human-centred recovery: Narrowing the digital divide". ### **DEPARTMENT OF COMPUTER SCIENCE**


