
NSS ACTIVITY-2022

NSS wing, SV University, Tirupati conducted one day awareness programme on **Drug De Addiction** on 22-01-2022. Drugs are dangerous to health. Millions of Indians are dependent on alcohol, cannabis, and opiates, and drug misuse is a pervasive phenomenon in Indian society. While most people think that addicts have a choice, in reality, an addict needs professional help because it is a chronic disorder. Drug addiction not only affects the substance abuser but also impacts families. They go through mental stress, face social consequences, and are pushed into financial crisis. The objective of the programme is to make the students aware about ill effects of drug addiction and the need for drug de-addiction. 160 students of affiliated colleges participated in the programme.



CENTRE FOR WOMEN'S STUDIES

Two days online awareness programme has been organized by in connection with **National Girl Child** UGC Centre for Women's studies Day on 24th and 25th January, 2022. It is celebrated on 24 January in India to spread awareness about the rights of girls and to highlight the inequalities that they face in their lives. The programme was organised to spread awareness about the inequalities faced by girls in Indian society, also to promote awareness about the rights of the girl child and the importance of female education, health, and nutrition along Beti Bachao Beti Padhao, and Save the Girl Child. 175 members from different states participated in this online programme.

The existence, training, support, and supervision of the community worker based in the community or operating from a nearby health facility are indispensable features of these programs. Thus community organizations are a key aspect of community-based health awareness..50 members participated in this programme.



NSS wing, SV University, Tirupati conducted **Clean and Green programme** at campus premises on 14-02-2022. The Clean and Green campaign aims to protect and care for the environment by engaging the community in leading an environmentally conscious lifestyle. 
